The event is a ride, not a race. Participants should be referred to by rider number whenever possible, as this is how they are tracked.

Please use your tactical designator when calling net control. Remember to identify with your callsign at the end of any series of transmissions.

Remember to dress for variable weather, stay hydrated, bring your radio, charged batteries, antenna, etc.

There ARE NO SIGNIFICANT route changes on the course this year, except of the location of Start/Finish.

Sags will be assigned a number at Start/ Finish. Sag kits, maps, and signage are available at Start / Finish. The cycle club may reimburse SAG units for gas on request (you may need to sign up on the event volunteer webpage) .

For best performance, APRS trackers should be set for a path of Wide 1-1, Wide 2-1 (Similar settings should work)
