- The numbers of anyone who drops out at your location and whether they need transportation (we will try). Please report when the cyclist is picked up and who is providing transportation.
- The numbers and times of the last cyclists departing your location.
- Please remember radios, batteries, paper, writing instrument, appropriate clothing for the weather changes, hat, sunscreen, water, food, etc.

146.700 - PL 179.9 (TAM),
 146.700 - PL 167.8(BARNABE),
 146.700 - PL 203.5 (BIG ROCK), or
 147.330 + PL 179.9 (TAM WEST)
 147.315 + PL 88.5 (ENGLISH HILL)
 146.910 - PL 88.5 (SONOMA MTN)
 Local Tactical 147.555 Simplex
 APRS Trackers 144.390 Simplex WIDE 1-1, WIDE 2-1
 145.170 – PL 88.5 (Pt. Reyes) and 146.865 – PL 88.5 (Dillon Beach) are linked to 146.910 (Sonoma Mtn.)

Whenever possible, please stay on the primary 146.700 Simulcast Repeaters (Multiple PL's), however use the best frequency for communications. We will monitor 146.700 and 146.910 throughout the event.

The event is a ride, not a race. Participants should be referred to by rider number whenever possible, as this is how they are tracked.
