2) Release times are approximate, based on past experience; maybe sooner, maybe later.

- 3) All stations should track the troop number, check-in time, the number of Scouts and adults, and relay to net control. **Example: "Checkpoint 3A, Troop 24, 5 Scouts, 3 Adults at Oh, Nine, One, Five"**
- 4) Please keep track of the troop numbers and dispositions of any participants who drop out at your location. Inform net control.
- 5) Remember to bring the usual supplies for an event, radios, spare battery, food, beverage, sunscreen, hat, etc.
